- (D) 93 TINSLEY PARK ROAD, SHEFFIELD, S9 5DL (AS SHOWN FOR IDENTIFICATION EDGED RED ON THE ATTACHED PLAN 4)**

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO THE DEFENDANTS AND PERSONS UNKNOWN

This Order prohibits you from doing the acts set out in this Order. You should read it very carefully. You are advised to consult a solicitor as soon as possible. You have the right to ask the Court to vary or discharge this Order.

UPON the order of Mrs Justice Stacey on 13 June 2025 granting an injunction to the Claimants until 13 December 2025

AND UPON the Claimants' application for an extension of the injunction (the "Application")

AND in light of the guidance provided by the Supreme Court in *Wolverhampton CC v London Gypsies & Travellers* [2024] 2 WLR 45

AND UPON the Claimants notifying Persons Unknown of the Application and evidence in support

AND UPON hearing Counsel for the Claimants regarding the Application and reading the supporting evidence

AND UPON the Claimants giving and the Court accepting the undertakings set out in Schedule 2 to this Order

AND UPON the "Land" being defined as comprising the following sites, as shown for identification edged red on the attached Plans 1-5 in Schedule 1:

a. Lumley Street Depot, Lumley Street, Sheffield, S4 7ZJ ("Site A")

b. Lumley Street Workshop, Lumley Street, Sheffield, S4 7ZJ ("Site B")

c. The Energy Recovery Facility at Bernard Road, Sheffield, S4 7YX but excluding that area of land shaded purple on Plan 3 ("Site C")

d. 93 Tinsley Park Road, Sheffield, S9 5DL ("Site D")

e. Crown Works, Rotherham Road, Beighton, Sheffield, S20 1AH ("Site E")

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

INJUNCTION

1. Until 23:59 on 13 June 2026 or final determination of the claim or further order in the meantime, whichever shall be the earlier, the Defendants must not, without the consent of the Claimants, enter, occupy or remain upon the Land.

2. Until 23:59 on 13 June 2026 or final determination of the claim or further order in the meantime, whichever shall be the earlier, the Defendants must not, without the consent of the Claimants, block or obstruct the exiting or entering of any other individual or vehicle to or from the Land.

3. In respect of paragraphs 1 and 2, the Defendants must not: (a) do it himself/herself/themselves or in any other way; (b) do it by means of another person acting on his/her/their behalf, or acting on his/her/their instructions.

4. For the avoidance of doubt, this injunction does not prohibit peacefully obtaining or communicating information, or peacefully persuading any person to work or abstain from working.

VARIATION

5. Anyone served with or notified of this Order may apply to the Court at any time to vary or discharge this Order or so much of it as affects that person but they must first give the Claimants' solicitors 72 hours' notice of such application. If any evidence is to be relied upon in support of the application the substance of it must be communicated in writing to the Claimants' solicitors at least 48 hours in advance of any hearing.

6. Any person applying to vary or discharge this Order must provide their full name, address and address for service.

7. The Claimants have liberty to apply to vary this Order.

SERVICE AND NOTIFICATION

8. Service of the Application and this Order is dispensed with, pursuant to CPR 6.16, 6.28 and 81.4(2)(c).
9. The Order shall be notified to Persons Unknown by the Claimants carrying out each of the following steps:
 - a. Uploading a copy of the Order onto the following website: <https://www.sheffield.veolia.co.uk/>.
 - b. Sending an email to neiltodd@Thompsons.law and neil.gillam@unitetheunion.org attaching a copy of this Order.
 - c. Affixing a copy of the Order in A4 size at those locations marked with an "x" on Plans 1-5. Monitoring that the Order remains affixed and legible is to be carried out by the Claimants in the first week of each month.
 - d. Affixing warning notices of A2 size at those locations marked with an "x" on Plans 1-5. Monitoring that the warning notices remain affixed and legible is to be carried out by the Claimants in the first week of each month.
10. Notification to Persons Unknown of any further applications shall be effected by the Claimants carrying out each of the following steps:
 - a. Uploading a copy of the application onto the following website: <https://www.sheffield.veolia.co.uk/>.
 - b. Sending an email to neiltodd@Thompsons.law stating that an application has been made and providing those application documents.
 - c. Affixing a notice at those locations marked with an "x" on Plans 1-5 stating that the application has been made and where it can be accessed online.
11. Notification of any further documents to Persons Unknown may be effected by carrying out the steps set out in paragraph 10(a)-(b) only.
12. In respect of paragraphs 9 to 11 above, effective notification will be deemed to have taken place on the date on which all of the relevant steps (except for the monitoring requirements in paragraph 9) have been carried out.

FURTHER DIRECTIONS

13. Liberty to apply.
14. Costs are reserved.

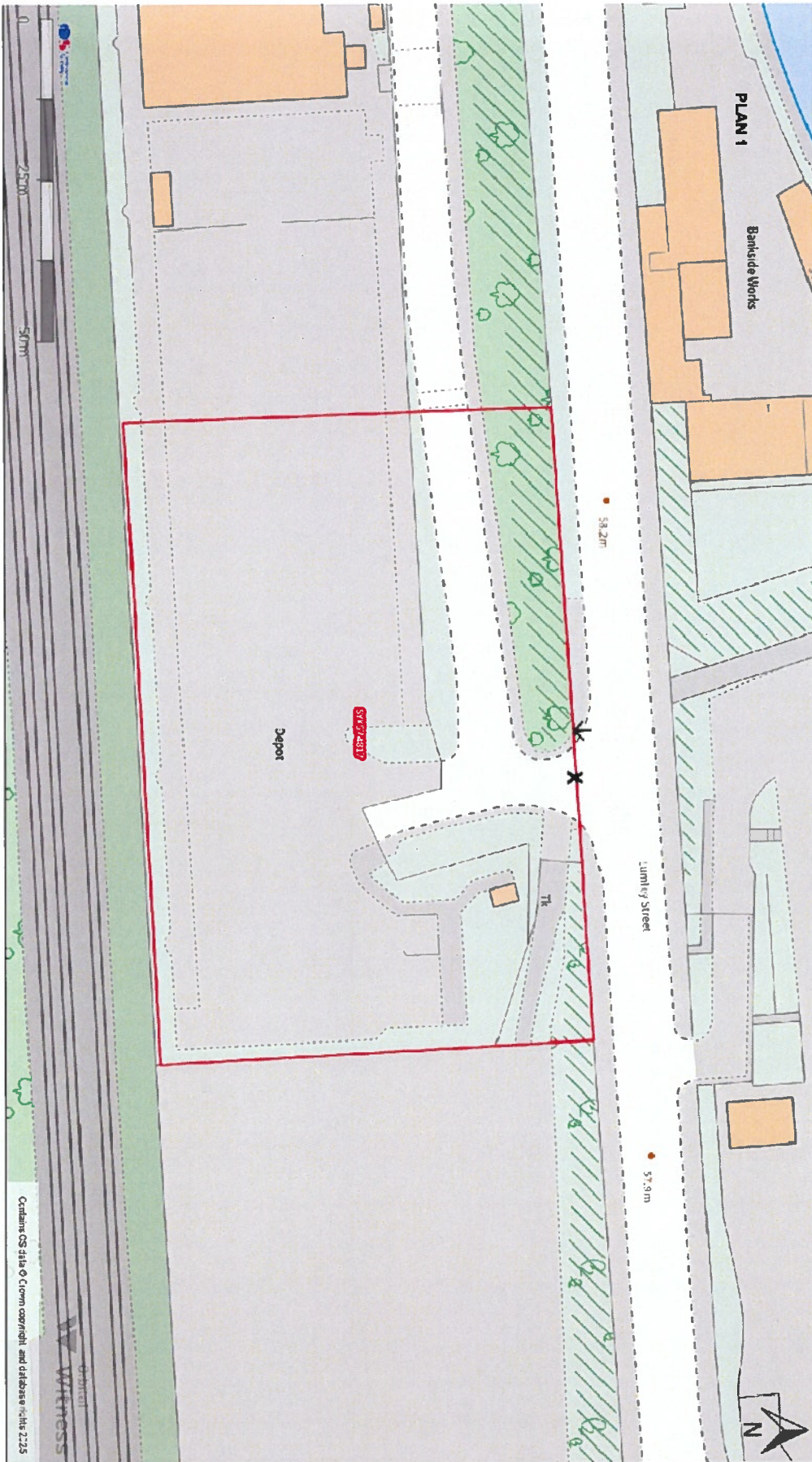

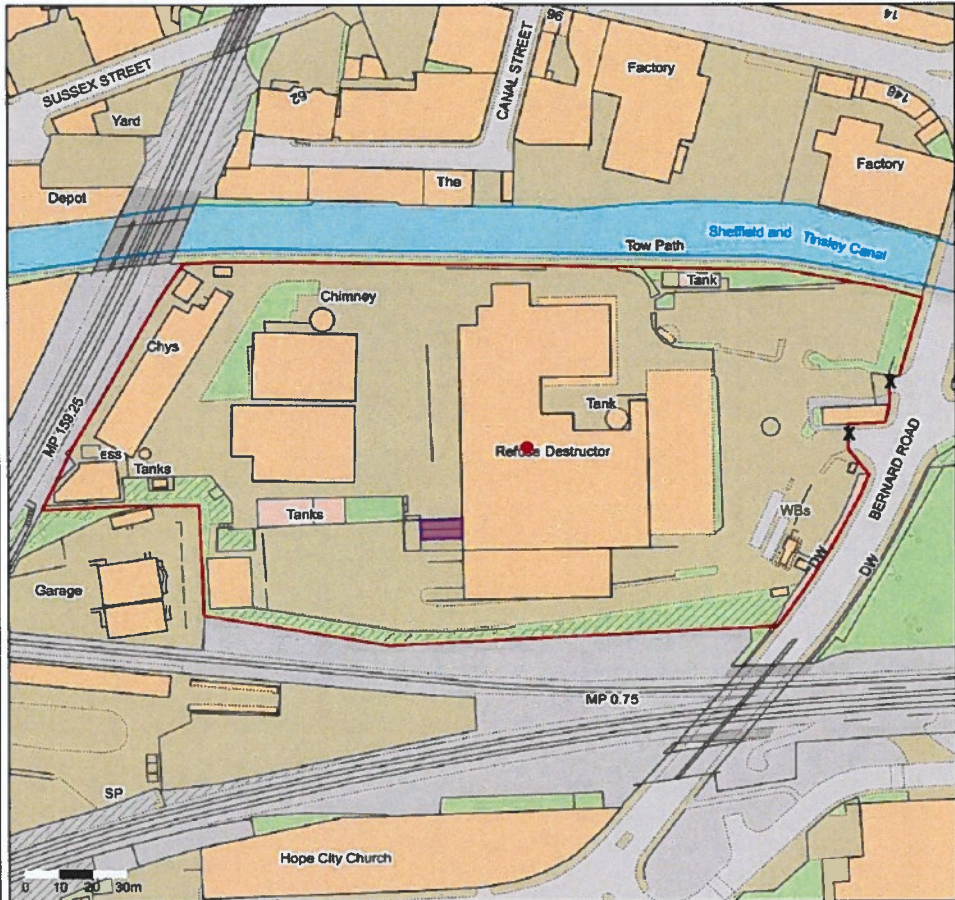

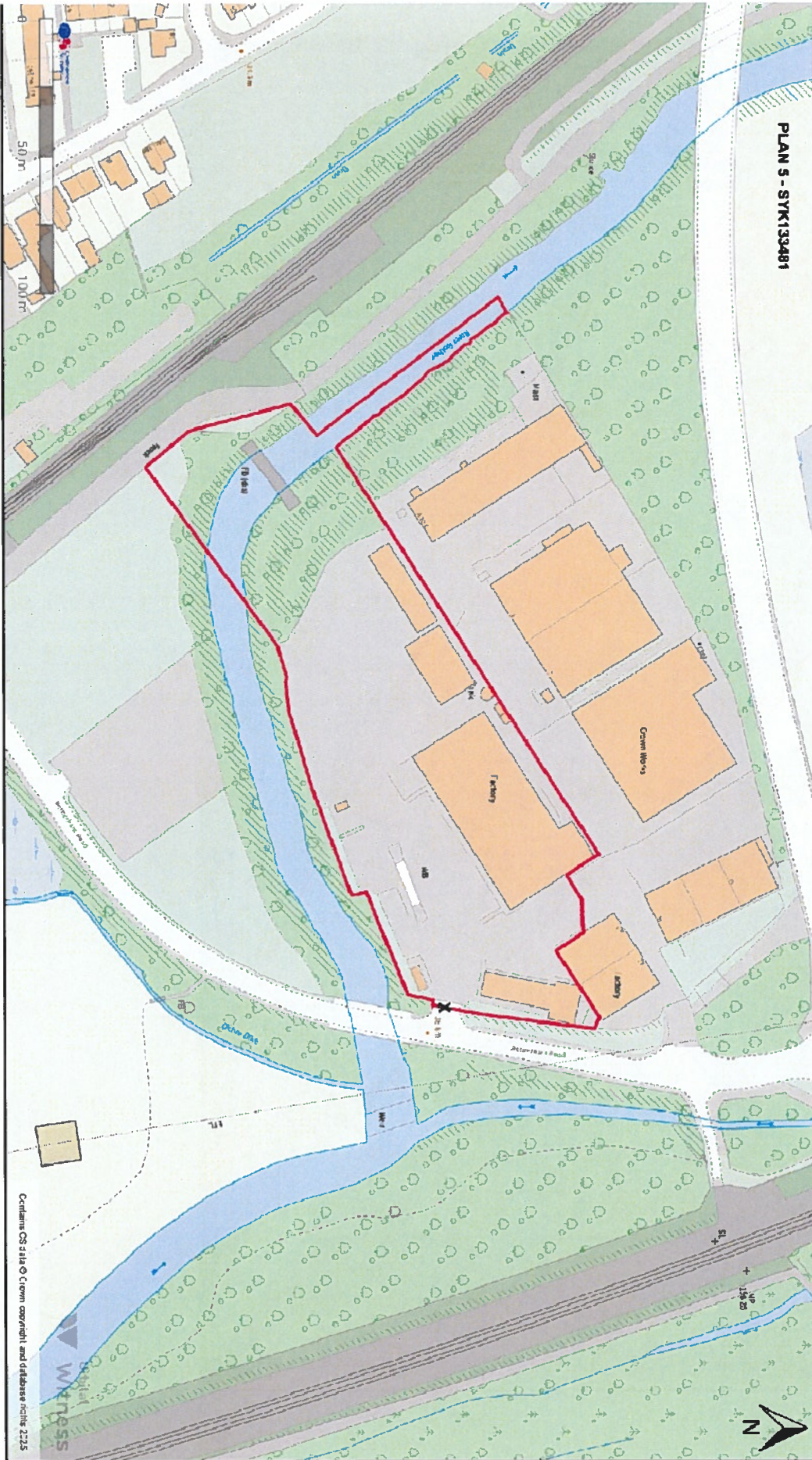

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SCHEDULE 2 - UNDERTAKINGS GIVEN BY THE CLAIMANTS

- (1) The First Claimant will comply with any order for compensation which the Court might make in the event that the Court later finds that the injunction in paragraphs 1-2 of this Order, in respect of Sites A-C, has caused loss to a future Defendant and the Court finds that the future Defendant ought to be compensated for that loss.

- (2) The Third Claimant will comply with any order for compensation which the Court might make in the event that the Court later finds that the injunction in paragraphs 1-2 of this Order, in respect of Sites D-E, has caused loss to a future Defendant and the Court finds that the future Defendant ought to be compensated for that loss.
